Objectives of the course

This Diploma course in hypnotherapy is designed to give you a thorough grounding in all aspects of hypnotherapy.

It is ideally structured for those who wish to follow a career in hypnotherapy and for those who want to increase their knowledge of the subject for their own interest and self-development.

The Diploma in Clinical Hypnotherapy offered by the Peak College of Hypnotherapy has been Assessed and Validated at Practitioner Level by the General Hypnotherapy Standards Council (UK). Graduates from this course are eligible for professional registration with The General Hypnotherapy Register (the GHSC's Registering Agency), together with the acquisition of the industry-based award –The General Qualification in Hypnotherapy Practice (GQHP).

This programme of study is designed to take account of the different educational levels of students and assumes no previous knowledge. There is no upper age limit and entry onto the course requires no previous academic qualifications. Commitment, integrity and temperament are far more important than your academic history.

Format of the Course

The Diploma in Clinical Hypnosis consists of nine separate modules and is split between:

- Classroom tuition
- Practical instruction
- Personal practice
- Self study

The classroom tuition will give you the foundation of knowledge that you require to learn hypnotherapy and to understand the basic psychology behind it.

Much of hypnosis can be seen as a practical skill. This course aims to give you those skills as well as a theoretical appreciation of the subject.

All skills improve with practice and you will be given the opportunity to practice your new-found skills in a friendly and supportive environment.

Finally, between the modules, assignments will be set and there will be some self-study reading required. This enhances the classroom tuition by giving some of the background to the subjects discussed.

The aim of the course is not to put unnecessary barriers between you and your success but to ensure that you complete the course fully qualified to practice as a Hypnotherapist.
